REQUIREMENTS FOR RECEIVING A PARKING PERMIT

- Student must be a senior.
- Seniors must also have completed the RHS Driver's Safety Training course and Driver's Education. A Certificate of Completion for Driver's Education and/or Driver's Safety Course taken outside of RHS must be attached.
- Seniors must hold a New York State Class D Senior License.
- Seniors must carry proof of their vehicle registration.
- Students & parents must sign this application.
- Students must show their original driver's license and car registration to the Dean of Students or designee before receiving a parking tag. Students must also bring a copy of these documents to the Dean's office before receiving a parking tag. These copies will NOT be made by RHS staff and students will not be permitted to use the office copier.

TO STUDENTS:

- Student parking is a privilege only for seniors who have met the above requirements.
- Students must obey all New York State Motor Vehicle Laws.
- Students must obey the posted campus speed limit.

Where can you park?

- **Students can park in designated Student parking spaces only.**

What is considered a parking violation?

- Not adhering to the requirements for parking on campus.
- Not obeying NYSDMV laws.
- Irresponsible driving (including but not limited to speeding, permitting riders on the outside of the vehicle while the vehicle is stopped or in motion, etc.).
- Parking in an administrative, faculty, staff, and/or adult education spaces.
- Parking or standing in the traffic circle in front of the school.

What are the consequences for a parking violation?

- If you park illegally and/or do not display your RHS hang tag, you will have an orange warning sticker placed on your window. At this time, we will note your license plate number and keep it on file. If a second violation occurs, the vehicle may be towed at the owner's expense.
- If you violate the parking procedures, you will also lose your parking privileges for the duration of the year and will receive in-school suspension for insubordination
- If you have had your parking privileges suspended and then incur another violation, you will face further disciplinary action, including out of school suspension and/or towing of your car at owner's expense.

INCLEMENT WEATHER

THE HIGH SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION RECOMMENDS THAT STUDENTS NOT DRIVE TO OR LEAVE SCHOOL DURING INCLEMENT WEATHER. THE CAMPUS MAY ALSO BE CLOSED FOR SAFETY REASONS ON THOSE DAYS.

TO PARENTS:

- The safety of your child when they are driving should be your utmost concern as a parent.
- Parents of seniors who park on campus understand that they are giving them permission to leave the school grounds during the school day with their cars due to the Open Campus policy.
- The cooperation of parents is essential in reinforcing the principles of safe driving and responsible use of an automobile.
