ParentChild+ is an evidence-based early literacy, parenting, and school readiness model, committed to closing the achievement gap by providing low-income families the skills and materials they need to prepare their children for school and life success. The Roslyn School District chapter provides ParentChild+ to two and three year olds living within the school district.

During 23 weekly home visits, volunteers provide the family with a high-quality book or educational toy that is a gift to the family. Using the book or toy, the home visitor models reading, conversation, and play activities designed to stimulate parent-child interaction, develop language and literacy skills, and build school readiness. Visits can be done after school hours. Visits are ideally twice a week for 30 minutes, but if scheduling doesn't allow for that, a longer visit can be done once a week.
