Art 6

Offered: Alternate Day

Type of Course: Required

This course gives students a wide variety of experiences in different media. Techniques in drawing, painting, sculpture, printing, and design are explored through various unit areas aimed at specific concepts and movements in art history.

Art 7

Offered: Alternate Day

Type of Course: Elective

Art 7 is an alternate day elective course that builds on the elements learned in Art 6. It is designed to give students a more extensive art experience. The curriculum delves into a wide variety of concepts and movements, while continuing the exploration of artistic techniques and materials.

Studio Art

Offered: Full Year (Meets the High School Diploma Requirement for 1 credit in Art or

Music.)

Prerequisite: Portfolio submission

Type of Course: Elective

Studio Art is an introductory high school course, which meets the New York State Diploma requirements for one credit of visual arts, music, dance, or theater. It is also a prerequisite course for students who wish to study advanced art courses in grades 9, 10, 11, & 12. Emphasis is placed on the elements and principles of design and art history. Students will have an opportunity to work with a variety of media. The final average will become part of the student's high school record and will be calculated in the high school grade point average. Students who successfully complete this course will receive one high school credit.
