Dear Harbor Hill Families:

WELCOME BACK

It is with great pleasure that I welcome you to the 2019-2020 school year at Harbor Hill School. Although there's no time like the summertime, September is always exciting. We have been busy all summer preparing for the arrival of Harbor Hill's incredible students on opening day. We look forward to seeing the children, catching up on all of their great summer stories and welcoming them to a new school year.

First Day of School

The first day of school will be Tuesday, September 3, 2019. Harbor Hill doors will open at 8:00 a.m. and dismissal time is at 2:30 p.m. Special area teachers and other staff members will greet the students as they arrive to assist and guide them as they locate their classrooms.

Bus Transportation

Bus transportation will be provided for all students. Bus passes and bus schedules will be mailed to you by the end of this month from the Transportation Office. If you do not receive your bus schedule by the end of the month, please call the Transportation Office at 801-5190. As you know, all students will also be assigned a seat on the bus. You will receive a color coded label in the mail with your child's bus seat assignment prior to the first day of school. As part of this initiative, our youngest students will sit in the front of the bus. The drivers have been made aware of this and will assist your child in finding their seat on the first day. If you have any additional questions or concerns regarding transportation, please contact me and I will be happy to assist you.

Cafeteria (Breakfast)

Every morning, the cafeteria offers a brown bag breakfast of cereal or bagel with milk and juice. Additional breakfast selections are listed on the monthly breakfast menu which is located on the Roslyn website (www.roslynschools.org). Students who were unable to have breakfast at home may stop at the cafeteria as they enter the school, purchase a breakfast bag, and eat breakfast in their classroom during the time when attendance is taken.

Cafeteria (Lunch)

The cafeteria will be open for lunch as of the first day of school. Daily food selections are listed on the monthly menu which is located on the Roslyn website (www.roslynschools.org). Our cafeteria offers a wide variety of lunches. Please review the selections with your child before the school day so your child will be prepared to order his/her lunch when the teacher takes the lunch count.

Prepayment for Breakfast and Lunch

The automated **Point-of-Sale (POS)** food service system (ScholarChip) continues to be available to families this year and is accessible on line at www.scholarconnect.com. This system is designed to add flexibility to your payment options while eliminating the risk of forgetting or losing money. Information describing this system in detail is available on the Roslyn website.

Prepayment is also available by sending or bringing a check or cash to school. Checks should be made payable to **Roslyn UFSD School Lunch Fund**. Please remember to include your child's name and teacher in the memo section of the check. The list of students with prepaid meals is kept by the cashier in the cafeteria through the use of a computerized system. The purchase of breakfast or lunch does not have to be made every day. As your child makes a purchase, his/her account is debited by the charges for that particular day.

Snacks

Please encourage your child to bring healthy snacks to school for classroom snack time. For the safety of our students who have nut allergies, we ask that you do not send snacks that contain peanuts or tree nuts. The school will be available for parents and students who wish to see the location of their classrooms on Tuesday, August 27, 2019 from 8:00 a.m. - 2:00 p.m. **Please be aware that teachers may not be here on that day and the classrooms may be locked for safety purposes.** Please do not bring your child's school supplies to school on August 27th. We ask that you have your child bring his/her supplies on the first day of school. If you have questions or need to contact us, please call the main office at 516-801-5400.

Open House

You will have an opportunity to meet the teachers and see the classrooms at our **Harbor Hill Open House** that will be held on **Wednesday, September 25, 2019**. Additional information concerning the times of this event will follow after the first day of school. At Open House, you will have the opportunity to visit your child's classroom and meet your child's classroom teacher, as well as learn about grade level curriculum, specials, and classroom activities.
