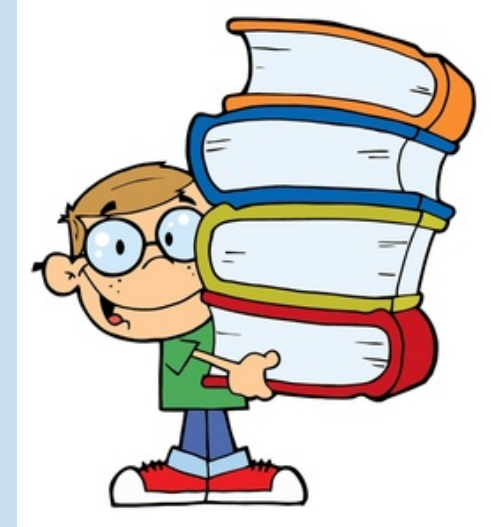


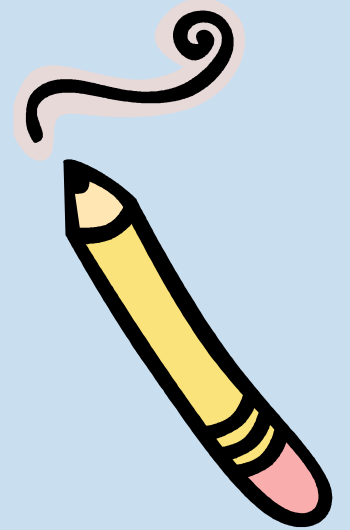

- Facilitate parent-team conferences
- Counselor is member of each 6th grade team
- Provide direct counseling services to individuals and groups
- Provide classroom guidance lessons on topics such as career exploration, goal setting, and conflict resolution.

MEETING WITH THE COUNSELOR



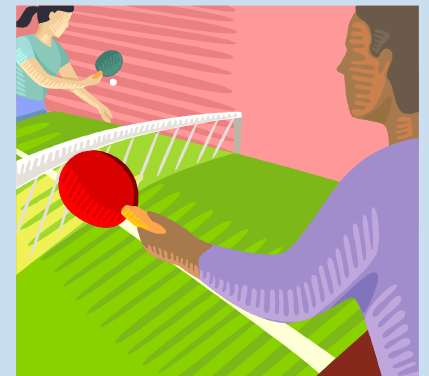
- Before school

Lunch Groups:

- All students are invited, beginning in the fall, to participate in lunch groups.
- Each group meets during lunch periods once a week for a 6-8 week period.
- Groups include: book club, study skills, current connections, scrapbooking.

TRANSITION PROGRAMS INCLUDE

- Curriculum night for parents
- Orientation programs for students
- Articulation meetings between elementary and middle school
- 6th grade counselor sits on CSE/504 meetings at the elementary level
- Summer orientation for all incoming 6th graders at the end of August (students receive lockers)
- Classroom guidance activities throughout the year
