Role of a School Counselor

- Advise students/parents on academic planning, career exploration, and social-emotional development
- Collaborate with teachers, administrators, and parents to identify academic and social/emotional needs
- Provide individual and small group counseling
- Classroom counseling lessons on topics such as career exploration, goal setting, and growth mindset
