Transition Programs Include

- Curriculum Night for parents/guardians
- Orientation programs for 5th grade students
- Articulation meetings between middle and elementary schools
- Buddy Program to support the transition to RMS
- 6th grade counselor attends all CSE/504 meetings in Spring 2025
- Summer orientation for incoming 6th graders (*end of August*)
- Counselor leads classroom activities in the Fall



Role of a School Counselor

- Advise students/parents on academic planning, interest exploration, and social-emotional development
- Collaborate with teachers, administrators, and parents to identify academic and social/emotional needs
- Provide individual and small group counseling
- Classroom counseling lessons on topics such as career exploration, goal setting, and decision making



Meeting with the Counselor

- Before School
- During Lunch
- After-School (during extra help)

Lunch Groups



- Beginning in the Fall, all students are invited to participate in lunch groups
- Each group meets during lunch periods once a week for a 6-8 week period
- Groups include: Middle School Transition, Current Connections, Games Club

Teaming

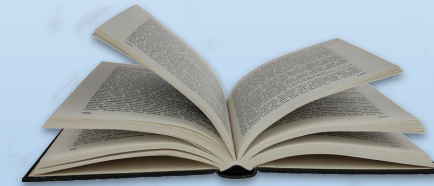
A “Team” consists of the School Counselor and the following teachers:

- English
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies
- Special Education

Students are divided into 2 teams (“Team 61” and “Team 62”) which allows for test planning and assemblies.

- Music, Media, and Production

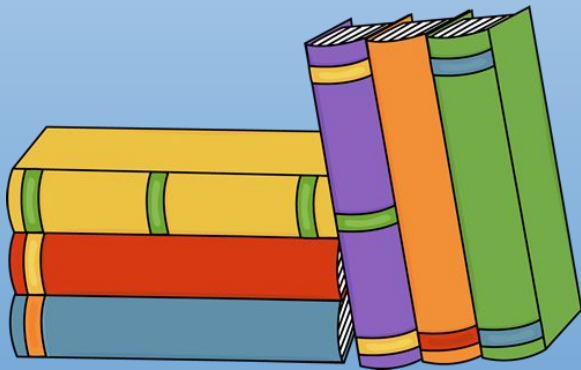
