Transition Programs Include

- Curriculum Night for parents/guardians

- Articulation meetings between middle and elementary schools
- 6th grade counselor is at all CSE/504 meetings in Spring, 2022
- Summer orientation for incoming 6th graders (end of August)
- Counselor leads classroom activities in the Fall



Role of a School Counselor

- Advise students/families on academic planning, career exploration, and social-emotional development
- Collaborate with teachers, administrators, and families to identify academic and social/emotional needs
- Provide individual and small group counseling
- Classroom counseling lessons on topics such as career exploration, goal setting, and growth mindset

- After School during extra help

Lunch Groups

- Beginning in the Fall, all students are invited to participate in lunch groups
- Each group meets during lunch periods once a week for a 6-8 week period
- Groups include: Middle School 101, Current Connections, Arts & Crafts

Teaming

- Musicology


