 - communication, healthy relationships, self-esteem, and stress management techniques



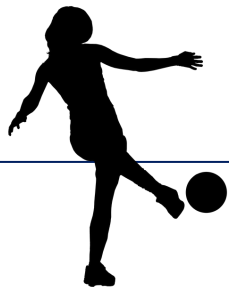
After-School Activities
