- Counselor leads classroom activities in the Fall




Role of a School Counselor

- Advise students/families on academic planning, career exploration, and social-emotional development
- Collaborate with teachers, administrators, and families to identify academic and social/emotional needs
- Provide individual and small group counseling
- Classroom counseling lessons on topics such as career exploration, goal setting and learning styles

Meeting with the Counselor

- Before school
- During lunch
- After school during extra help

Lunch Groups



- Beginning in the fall, all students are invited to participate in lunch groups
- Each group meets during lunch periods once a week for a 6-8 week period
- Groups include: Middle School 101 and Current Connections

Teaming

A "Team" consists of the school counselor and the following teachers:

- Special Education

Students <u>choose one</u> music class which meets on an alternate day:


