
Transition Programs Include

- Curriculum Night for parents/guardians
- Orientation programs for 5th grade students
- Articulation meetings between middle and elementary schools
- 6th grade counselor is at all CSE/504 meetings in Spring, 2023
- Summer orientation for incoming 6th graders (*end of August*)
- Counselor leads classroom activities in the Fall



Role of a School Counselor


- Advise students/families on academic planning, career exploration, and social-emotional development
- Collaborate with teachers, administrators, and families to identify academic and social/emotional needs
- Provide individual and small group counseling
- Classroom counseling lessons on topics such as career exploration, goal setting and learning styles



Meeting with the Counselor

- Before school
- During lunch
- After school during extra help

Lunch Groups



- Beginning in the fall, all students are invited to participate in lunch groups
- Each group meets during lunch periods once a week for a 6-8 week period
- Groups include: Middle School 101 and Current Connections

Teaming

A “Team” consists of the school counselor and the following teachers:

- English
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies
- Special Education

Students are divided into 2 teams (“Team 61” and “Team 62”)

Students choose one music class which meets on an alternate day:


- Chorus 6

6th Grade Courses by Teacher Recommendation


