Health Requirements for KINDERGARTEN ENTRANCE

New York State Law requires a <u>yearly physical</u>, <u>immunizations and dental exam</u> on each child entering kindergarten. The physical must be signed, stamped, and dated by your child's pediatrician no later than <u>1year</u> from the start of school. Please forward all information to the Heights School's Health Office <u>no later than August 1</u>.

The following immunizations <u>are required</u> for entrance into kindergarten under New York State Department of Health, Public Health Law, Section 2164:

Immunization	Required Doses
DTap or DTP	5 doses 4 doses if the 4 th dose is given at 4 years of age or older 3 doses if series started at age 7 or older
Polio	4 doses 3 doses of the 3 rd dose given at 4 years of age or older
Measles/Mumps/Rubella (MMR)	2 doses
Hepatitis B	3 doses
Varicella (chicken pox)	2 dose

These are the <u>minimum</u> requirements by state law. Most children by the age of 5 years will have received a booster to some of the above mentioned immunizations.

<u>Please Note:</u> If your child's yearly physical is scheduled during the fall months, you can <u>NOT</u> wait until their **5yr** check-up to receive any missing required immunizations. *All of these* required immunizations can be received after 4 years of age. You must schedule an appointment prior to the start of school to receive that particular vaccine. The physical exam can wait until their usual appointment time, and I can accept the physical dated from the previous year.
