I'm writing with some reminders about our November District Calendar.

Friday, November 1, 2024 is a Superintendent's Conference Day, which means no class for students. Schedules for athletic teams will be provided by coaches, as per Section VIII Athletics. All after-school activities are canceled.

Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024, the Roslyn School District will host a districtwide **Full Remote Instructional Day**. This is being done to allow the district a practice day to troubleshoot unforeseen issues, as well as familiarize and reinforce practices, so that if the district needs to go remote due to inclement weather or any other reason, everyone will be comfortable and productive. Please note that this Full Remote Instructional Day will operate on a **two-hour delayed opening schedule**. The students will log on two hours later than the normal school day.

Schools will be closed during our Thanksgiving Recess, **Thursday, November 28, 2024** and **Friday, November 29th, 2024**.
