#2 Proposed Draft Budget Presentation Update

Challenges & Reduction in State Aid

- Governor Hochul outlined changes in her proposed 25-26 State Budget that adversely affects Roslyn.
- For 2025-2026, our district is expected to receive an overall *decrease of \$305,162* in State Aid.
- State Aid reduction is not an accurate representation of present economic condition.
- Reduction of about 10% in our state aid ratio while our enrollment continues to increase
- Out of the \$11,171,177 state aid, about \$3 million is money that only comes back to us as a small percentage of what we have already spent on things such as transportation and buildings
- \$864,525 should be excluded from state aid totals as the District is used as a pass through to fund money to outside Pre-K agencies

Revisions to Lower the Budget

- Salary retiree breakages reduction
- Decrease in TRS projection rates
- Decrease in workers compensation premium
- Decrease in dollar amount for elementary contingency position
- Decrease in cybersecurity insurance premium

Levy Limit and Tax Levy

- LEVY LIMIT: Formula devised by NYS to determine the maximum % increase in real estate taxes for the Roslyn Community
- * TAX LEVY: Amount of real estate taxes needed after all available revenues are applied to offset the cost of the budget
