RESOLVED, the budget of the necessary claims and expenditures in the Roslyn Union Free School District in the Towns of North Hempstead and Oyster Bay for the school year 2021-22 amounting to **\$118,663,250** for "School Purposes" and **\$5,095,669** for "Library Purposes" totaling **\$123,758,919** is hereby accepted, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has estimated the revenue from all other sources including State Aid to be **\$19,966,921**; and

WHEREAS, the Library Board of Trustees has estimated the revenue from all other sources for 2021-22 to be **\$31,300**;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the sums of **\$98,696,329** for "School Purposes" and **\$5,064,369** for "Library Purposes" totaling **\$103,760,698** being the remainder of the budget adopted as above and the net amount which must be raised by taxation for the Roslyn Union Free School District, be levied upon the taxable property of said school district as said property has been certified to the Nassau County Board of Assessors for the school year 2021-22.

RESOLVED, that the District Clerk of this School District is hereby authorized and directed, pursuant to Section 6-20.0 and amendments thereto of the Nassau County Administrative Code, to file a certified copy of these resolutions with the

Nassau County Legislature and the Department of Assessment, Mineola, New York, on or before August 16, 2021.
