Dear Students and Parents,

The NYSSMA (New York State School Music Association) Solo Music Festivals will be held on the following dates in 2024:

All Roslyn instrumentalists, pianists and vocalists are eligible to participate in the NYSSMA festivals. But students wishing to audition for All State must currently be in tenth or eleventh grade. Students are given the opportunity to perform a prepared piece before a judge and receive a written evaluation and grade. For older students, these marks weigh heavily on their acceptance into All County and All State organizations.

Music must be selected from the current NYSSMA Manual (Edition 33 - Effective July 2022). If your child is enrolled in private instruction, they should consult the private teacher regarding the choice of music, otherwise the school music teacher can assist in selecting a piece. It is the responsibility of the student to prepare the music for these festivals; however, all students must register through a Roslyn school music teacher.

If your child is interested in participating, please download and fill out the appropriate form, and return it along with the correct fee to their school music teacher no later than **January 12, 2024. NO LATE FORMS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** The registration fees for the different festivals are below.

Level 1-4 (non-piano) \$16.00

Level 1-4 (piano) \$22.00

Level 5 & 6 (non-piano) \$ 24.00

Level 5 & 6 (piano) \$ 30.00

All State \$30.00
