In recognition of Autism Awareness Month, the Roslyn SEPTA, in conjunction with the Bryant Library of Roslyn, is pleased to present a live, inspirational talk with Dr. Temple Grandin on Monday, April 19th at 7pm. It will be followed by a Q&A.



Dr. Temple Grandin is well known for her trailblazing work on autism and animal behavior. Her life's work has been to understand her own autistic mind and share that knowledge with the world. Today, she is a prominent author, speaker, and professor of Animal Science at Colorado State University. Previously, she had a successful career consulting on livestock handling equipment design and animal welfare.

Her media appearances include: Larry King Live, 20/20, 60 Minutes, and a 2010 TED talk. Articles about her have been published in Time Magazine, The New York Times, Discover Magazine, Forbes, and USA Today. HBO made an Emmy-Award winning movie about her life, and in 2016, she was inducted into the American Academy of Arts and Sciences.
