# Causes of WW1

**The Spark**: Archduke Ferdinand assassination – by Serbian gunman, leads Austria to invade Serbia Russia had a treaty to help Serbia Germany came to aid of Austria-Hungary France and Britain join to help Russia against Germany; All of Europe drawn into war Triple Alliance or Central Powers v. Triple Entente(Allied Powers)

traditional foreign policy - neutrality, since Washington

Reasons for Involvement in WW1:

- 1. Closer ties with Allies
- 2. German Actions
  - a. Invasion of neutral Belgium
  - b. Unrestricted submarine warfare
  - c. Zimmerman telegram
- 3. Economic Ties and Loans

# The US at War:

Fed. Govt assumes sweeping powers

- over business and workers;
- Military draft
- Restrictions on civil liberties Espionage and Sedition Acts, freedom to criticize the war effort were limited;

Jobs filled by women;

Taxes increased; war bonds sold to raise money

Entrance of US into war on side of Allies helped swing tide of battle in their favor; Armistice, November 1918

### The Peace Settlement:

Wilson's 14 Points(1918) – aims to prevent future wars; free of seas national states and League of Nations The Versailles Treaty (1919)

- Harsh on Germany
- Austria-Hungary divided up into new, smaller national states
- A League of Nations established;

### **US Refuses to Join League of Nations**

US Senators concerned that US troops would often be called upon to stop acts of aggression overseas. Senate voted against the treaty and US never joined. US returns to isolationism.
