## INSTRUCTIONS

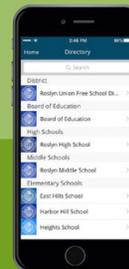

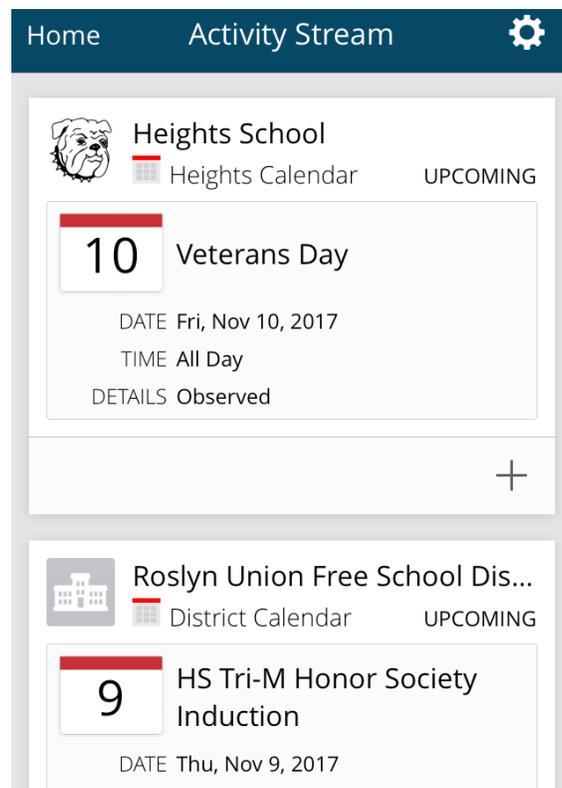
Locate important school information on the go

**Open the app.** The first screen you see is the home screen. It displays “Top Stories” scrolling across the top and several icons on the bottom.



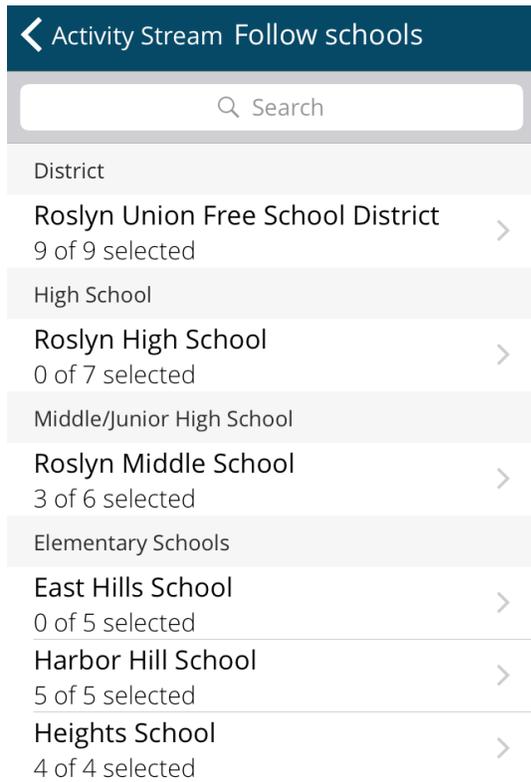

**Click on Activity Stream.** This is a collection of news items, upcoming events, announcements, and social media posts. You can personalize these settings by clicking on the settings icon in the upper right corner.



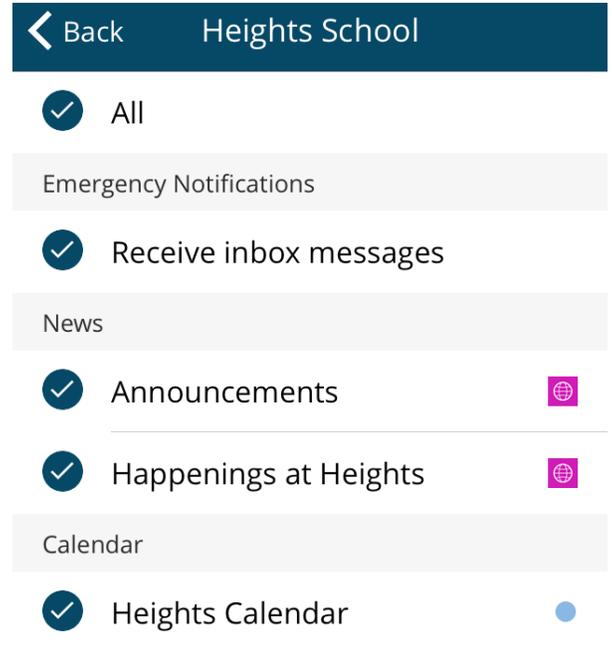

**Click on the settings icon.** Choose which activities the app will display by clicking on a school and selecting feeds. The user in this image has opted to view activities from the district and several schools.

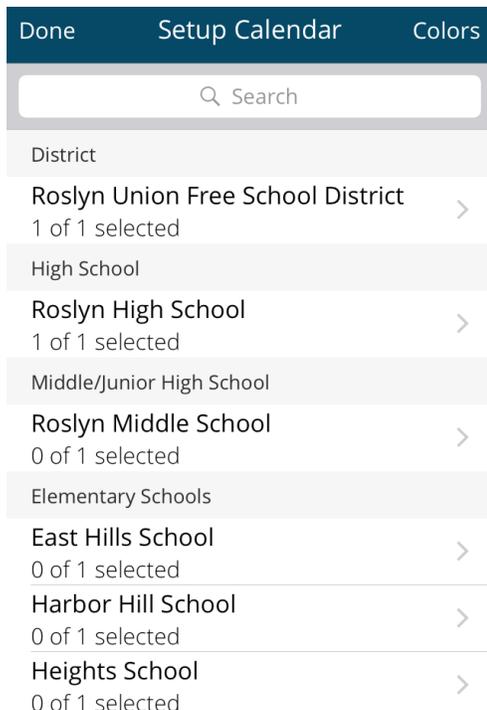
**Choose activities.** These are the Activity Stream options for Heights. All of the schools have similar options. (You can also choose settings for the Activity Feed by clicking on the main Settings icon on the next screen; see instruction panels 8-11 for details.) Click Back to return to the previous screen.

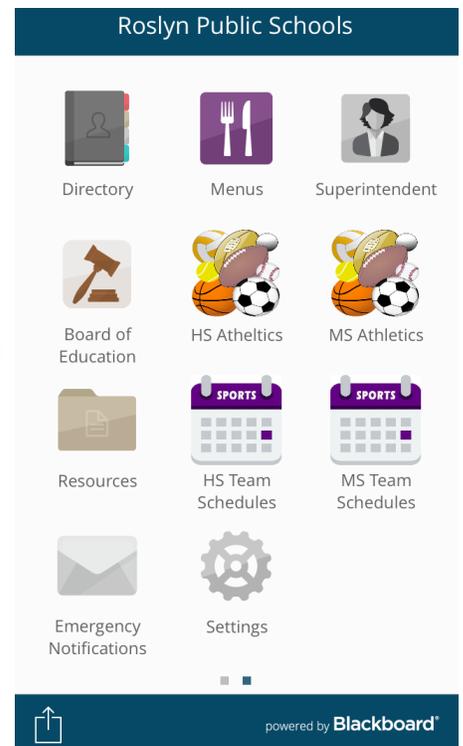
**Return to the home screen.** Try the Calendar and News feeds. You can select the settings icon on each of these screens, and again choose which schools' information you want to display. This user has chosen to display district and high school calendar items only.

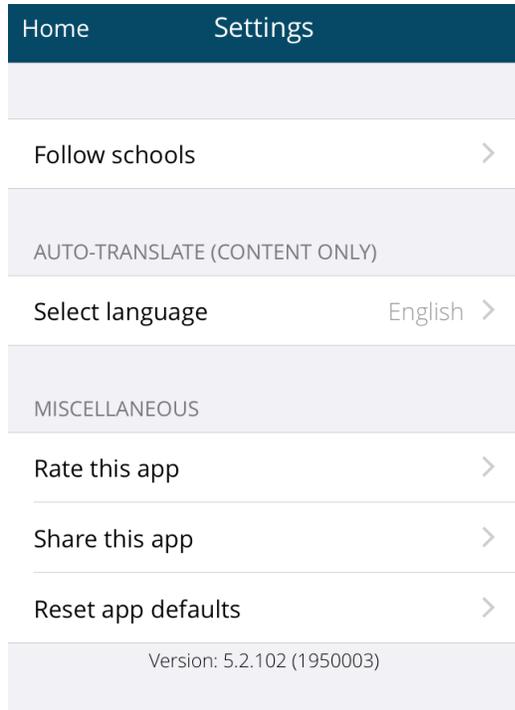
**Swipe right to view the next screen.** Several of these feeds are integrated with the district's website: Board of Ed, Superintendent, HS & MS Athletics, and Menus. Directory contains staff members' emails. Emergency Notifications will be activated only in an actual emergency. Resources contains links to additional web pages.

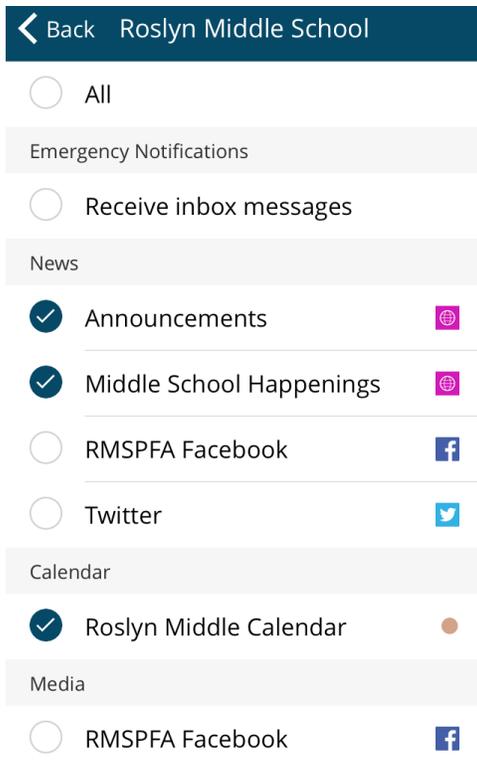
# Settings

Click on the main Settings icon on the second screen. Settings for individual features – such as calendar, news and activity stream – are consolidated here. Select “Follow Schools” to choose which features in which particular schools you wish to display on your app.



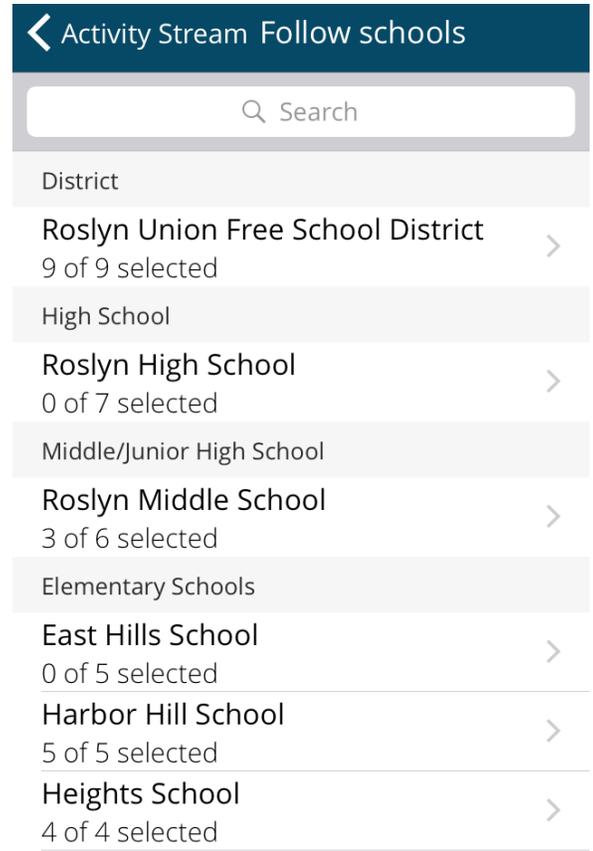

**Select features.** This user has chosen to display several feeds from the Roslyn Middle School: announcements, news items (“Happenings”) and the school’s calendar.

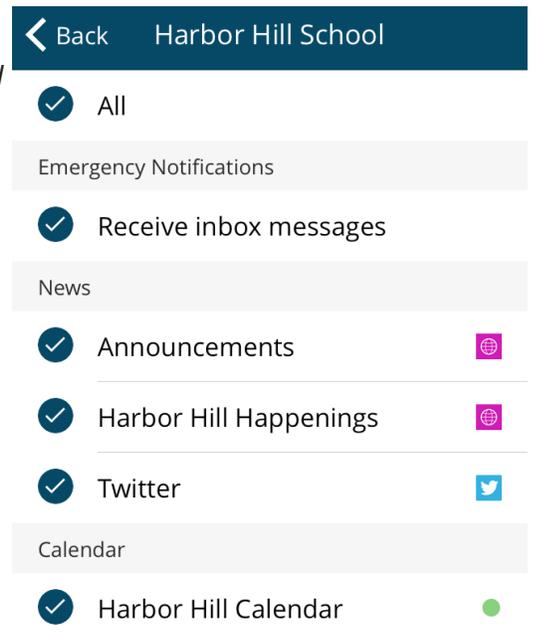
**Choose a school.** Select a school from which you wish to display information.

**Select features.** By selecting “All”, this user has chosen to display all feeds from Harbor Hill School: notifications, announcements, school news (“Happenings”), Twitter feeds and the school’s calendar.

*Settings adjusted in any of the features, such as activity stream, calendar or news, will automatically be adjusted here in the main settings, and vice versa.*
