

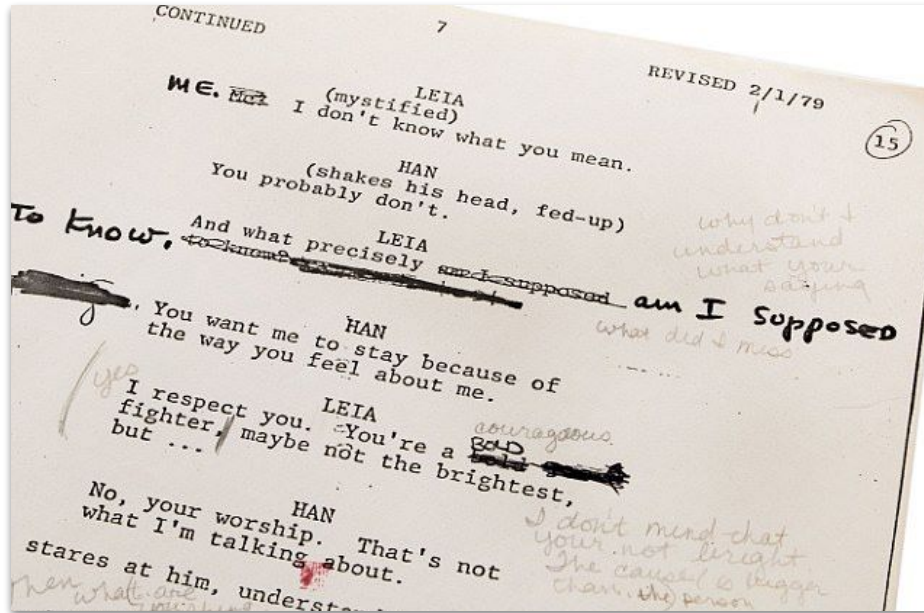

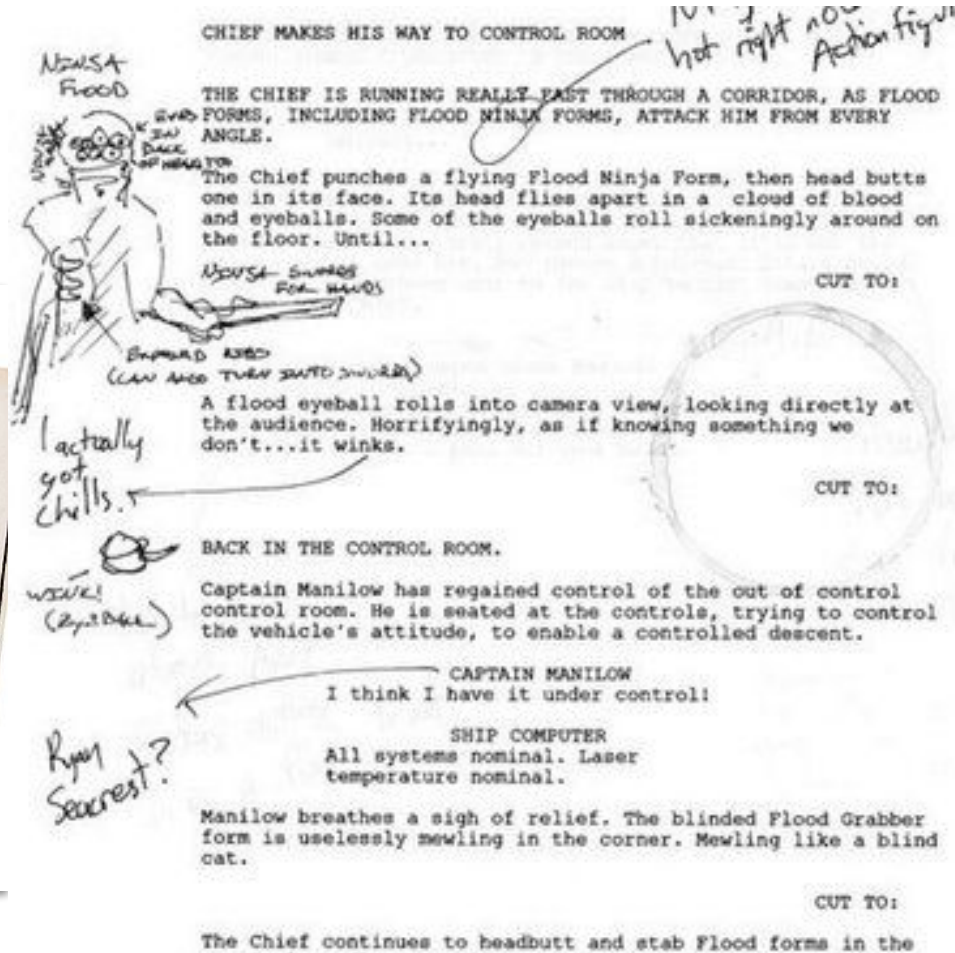

Fiction writing: The reader experiences life vicariously* through the protagonist.

*Vicariously: in a way that is experienced in the imagination through the actions of another person (or character)



We feel what they feel.



As you're reading, try to imagine the book being made into a movie or video game.

- Can this book be made into a movie or game?
- Who would be the actors to play (or voice) the characters?
- Think about the book as a movie (or game) from the different points of view of the characters.
- What would the setting look like?
- What might you change about the story?

***We become* the characters when we watch movies or play video games. We feel what they feel.**

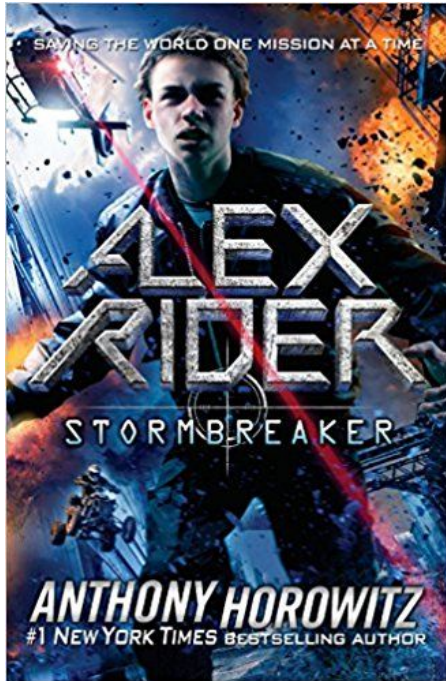
We might feel scared for or criticize the actions of the protagonist.

We might feel the adrenaline rush when playing a game.

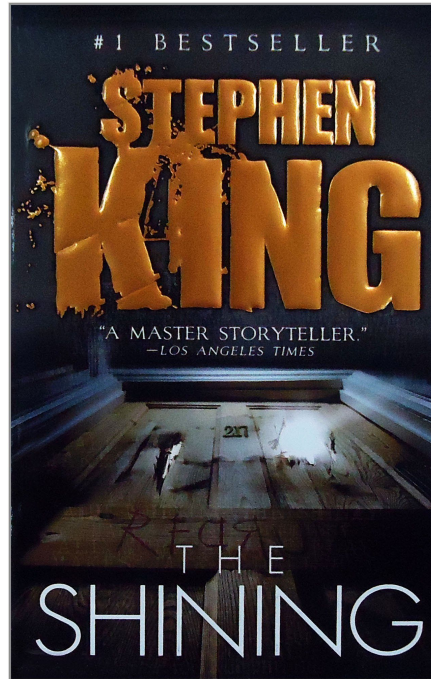
We might feel happy when the protagonist finally finds love.



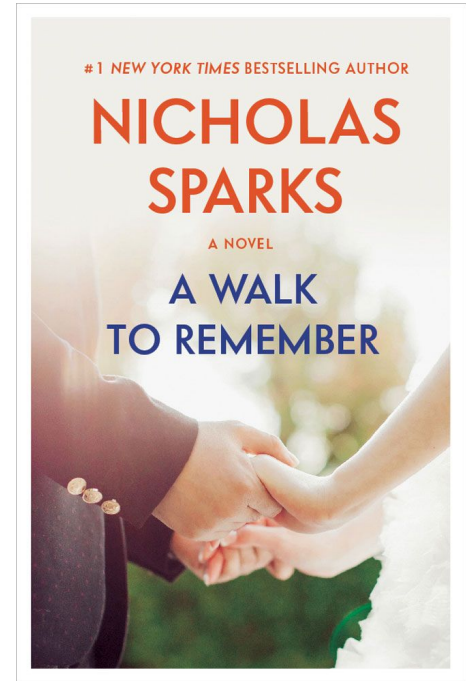
When we read fiction, we become the characters and experience their emotion.
