Our Community

The Roslyn Union Free School District is situated less than 20 miles from midtown Manhattan. The school district covers an area of five square miles and encompasses a group of primarily residential communities on Long Island's north shore, including the historic Village of Roslyn and all or part of East Hills, Flower Hill, Greenvale, Roslyn Estates, Roslyn Harbor and Roslyn Heights. Social-emotional learning, global awareness, human relations, and multicultural perspectives are emphasized in all subject areas.

Our students engage in a rigorous academic program while at the same time taking advantage of the opportunities provided by more than 50 clubs and organizations, a three-season athletic program, and creative and performing arts programs. This provides the foundation for a well-rounded educational experience for every child.

Academic Program

We offer a rigorous college preparatory curriculum for all our students. The curriculum includes accelerated programs in mathematics, science, and world language; honors opportunities in all academic areas, as well as Advanced Placement (AP) programs in a variety of subjects. In addition, partnerships with SUNY Farmingdale, Rochester Institute of Technology, St. John's University and Adelphi University permit our students to take college-level courses in technology, English, business, world languages and science. Broad offerings in art, business, industrial arts, and music are available to all students.

Learning Through COVID-19

We were fully remote for the spring of 2020. During the fall 2020-2021 academic year, we offered students the choice between full remote or hybrid instruction. In February 2021, we transitioned all students back to in-person learning with a continued live streaming full remote option. In the fall of 2021, the entire school community transitioned back to in person learning with no remote learning option. Our learning model and instruction has been consistent with the rigorous expectations and high standards to which all Roslyn students have been accustomed.

Course Weighting

All honors, research honors, and AP courses are weighted. The final grades in all subjects for which a grade is given are listed on the transcript. Final course averages will be multiplied by a numerical amount depending on the level of the course and will be reflected on the transcript in the weighted GPA.

- Regents Level Courses x 1.00 (ex. 95 average x 1.00 = 95.0)
- Honors or Accelerated Courses x 1.08 (ex. 95 average x 1.08 = 102.6)
- Research Honors Courses x 1.09 (ex. 95 average x 1.09 = 103.5)
- Advanced Placement Courses x 1.10 (ex. 95 average x 1.10 = 104.5)

Cumulative Averages (Class of 2024)

Grade point averages, computed at the end of junior year, includes all subjects except for those courses in which only pass-fail grades are issued. Our unweighted senior class GPA distribution ranges from 99.37 to 66.42. Our weighted GPA ranges from 106.03 to 66.42.

Graduation Rate (Class of 2024)

The Class of 2024 consisted of 251 students, with a 99% graduation rate.

- 100% of graduates earned a Regents Diploma.
- 88% graduated with a Regents Diploma with Advanced Designation.
- 37% received the Honors Designation by scoring an average of 90 or higher on 9 Regents Examinations.
