

### Next Steps After High School Post-Secondary Options

#### **Community Colleges**

- Offer associate degrees and certificates.
- Transfer options to four-year universities.

#### **Four-Year Universities**

- Offer bachelor's degrees in various fields.
- Involves a deeper study of a major.

#### **Technical and Vocational Schools**

- Focus on specific trades or skills.
- Programs typically shorter (6 months to 2 years).
- High demand for skilled workers in various industries.
- Apprenticeships:Combine on-the-job training with classroom instruction. Typically last 1-5 years

### **Additional Post-Secondary Options:**

**Military Academies**: Highly selective schools for those pursuing leadership in the military.

- United States Military Academy (West Point) Army.
- United States Naval Academy (Annapolis) Navy & Marine Corps.
- United States Air Force Academy (Colorado Springs) Air Force.
- United States Coast Guard Academy Coast Guard.
- United States Merchant Marine Academy Merchant Marines.

**Military Service:** Serve in one of the U.S. military branches (Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard).

**GAP Year:** Taking time off before further education for opportunities to travel, work, or volunteering.
