Dear Roslyn Families,

I am writing to inform you about a **current statewide technical issue affecting the computer-based testing (CBT) requirement** that East Hills Elementary School and Roslyn Middle School students (grades 4-8) were scheduled to participate in today.

The testing platform used by the New York State Education Department (NYSED), would not allow our Roslyn Middle School students to complete the exam, and NYSED has directed us to pause testing for the day. East Hills students did not begin the exam; their test is being postponed.

We are presently awaiting an update from NYSED, however, we have been mandated to collect all chromebooks from the **middle school** that were used in today's testing. Therefore, middle school students will not be bringing them home today.

This situation is incredibly frustrating and disheartening, especially considering the dedication our teachers have shown in preparing students for these assessments. Our students have worked hard and deserve a testing experience that reflects that effort.

We hope this issue is resolved quickly. Our school principals will follow up as soon as they have more information.
