Sculpture & Ceramics is an introductory course where students will work with a variety of materials including clay, Styrofoam, wire, found objects and wood. Clay techniques include hand building, decoration, and glazing. Sculptural techniques include modeling, construction, and assemblage. Students who are considering the Advanced Placement 3D Design course need to take this course.
