COURSE: Spanish 5H Culture/(Adelphi)

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF COURSE:

Spanish 5H (Culture) is a new course developed by the foreign language department to offer an opportunity for our students to earn college credit while experiencing an enhanced language curriculum taught by one of our teachers. This course is opened to students who have taken the New York State Regents. Upon completion the students will earn three Adelphi University credits, at a reduced cost, accepted in many colleges and universities in the United States. The students will also be able to attend cultural events and use the Adelphi University library. Students will receive an application for credit from Adelphi University. The cost for the course is \$335.00.

CURRICULUM OF COURSE:

This course will review basic elements of grammar taught in the New York State Checkpoints A and B and will introduce advanced grammar topics as prescribed in the NYS Checkpoint C of the LOTE state syllabus. The course will be taught in a communicative approach incorporating old and new grammar, vocabulary, idiomatic expressions in a thematic/cultural structure based on units from Mundo 21 Hispano by Houghton Mifflin. Six units of study with four subunits based thematically on the countries of the Spanish speaking world that tie naturally to a geographic region will be covered.

TEXTBOOK:

Mundo 21

EVALUATION:

Quizzes, unit exams, oral reports, midterm, final exam and participation in class discussion will determine the final grade for the students.

This course will be conducted in Spanish.
