NAME OF COURSE: INVESTIGATIVE LAW: CSI ROSLYN

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF COURSE

This hands-on course challenges students to become legal investigators and to use methods actually used by lawyers and detectives to solve case mysteries. Students will engage daily in role play and will be presented with real-life problem scenarios, which they will analyze with their investigative team. Investigative techniques such as wiretapping, fingerprinting, documentary evidence, crime scene analysis, interrogation, and interviewing will be taught and used in class simulations. Evidentiary rules of law will be explored with emphasis on legal ethics, reform, rights of victims and those accused of civil and criminal wrongs.
