GRADUATION DECORUM AND DRESS - JUNE 2019

The Graduation Ceremony is a serious occasion which commemorates a milestone of scholastic attainment.

To ensure the **proper dignity of the ceremony**, the following guidelines have been established:

- 1. In addition to the candidates for graduation, **everyone** participating in the ceremony will be wearing caps and gowns.
- 2. Girls must wear dresses, skirts, or slacks. Boys must wear collared shirts and long pants; jackets are not needed (ties are suggested).
 - No jeans or shorts are permitted for boys or girls.
- 3. All students must wear shoes (no sneakers, bare feet, or sandals).
- 4. Caps are to be placed on the head so that the mortar board is level; the tassel is worn **on the left side**. The caps are worn throughout the graduation ceremonies. **DO NOT REMOVE THEM FOR THE PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE AND THE NATIONAL ANTHEM.**

There will be no inappropriate wording, messages, or 3-D decorations on the tops of the mortar boards.

Any student wearing a cap deemed unacceptable will be removed from the graduation procession and may not participate in the graduation ceremony.

- 5. **<u>Proper behavior will be expected throughout the afternoon.</u>** The ceremony will be stopped if there are instances of inappropriate behavior. Students will be removed if necessary.
- 6. Parents and students should arrange a place to meet after the ceremony.
- 7. Students should come to pick up their actual diplomas which will be distributed beginning on Tuesday, June 24, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. in the Main Office.

GRADUATES PLEASE NOTE:

For the graduation ceremony, please do not carry money, valuables, or pocketbooks. Do not bring any item to graduation which will detract from the ceremony.
