It is understood that: 1) the work of the change orders is required in order to continue the projects; 2) a formal change order prepared by the architect and executed by the architect and the contractor and the construction manager will be subsequently presented for formal approval by the board of education and executed by the board president at a future meeting; and 3) the amount estimated for these change orders will be the maximum allowed unless specifically approved by the BOE when the formal change order is presented.
 - HH General Construction PCO#7: Stalco, Inc. Proposed Change Order #7 (Harbor Hill) for substitute work **at no additional cost**. This change order represents the replacement of the deteriorated terrazzo tile with Urethane Cement Resin Chip Flooring.

HS General Construction PCO#23: Stalco Proposed Change Order #23 (High School) for additional work at an estimated cost of \$7,100. This change order represents the cost to provide Ceilings, soffits & Fascia at Corridor 11, 14 & 14 A not shown on drawing.

B.6. Recommendation to approve a pending change order as indicated below. It is understood that: 1) the work of the change orders is required in order to continue the projects and meet the projected completion date; 2) a formal change order prepared by the architect and executed by the architect and the construction manager and the contractor will be subsequently presented for formal approval by the board of education and executed by the board president at a future meeting; and 3) the amount estimated for these change orders will be the maximum allowed unless specifically approved by the BOE when the formal change order is presented.

HS General Construction PCO#24: Stalco Proposed Change Order #24 (High School) for additional work at an estimated cost of **\$4,000**. This change order represents the cost to change Existing Sanitary structure elevation which is in the way of new walkway and asphalt.

HS Mechanical Construction PCO#3: Hi-Tech Proposed Change Order #3 (High School) for additional work at an estimated cost of **\$1,800**. This change order represents the cost to cut and cap existing steam piping in way of the new doorway from student lounge to school store, an unforeseen condition concealed within existing wall.
