BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education authorizes the Board President to execute the first amendment to the agreement dated, December 14, 2017.

B.2. WHEREAS, the Board of Education of the Roslyn Union Free School District entered into an agreement with North Shore Monuments dated, December 14, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the parties wish to amend the agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education of the Roslyn Union Free School District approves the second amendment to the agreement between the parties, dated December 14, 2017 pending attorney approval; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Education authorizes the Board President to execute the second amendment to the agreement dated, December 14, 2017.

B.3. Recommendation to adopt the following resolution with respect to the setting of the School District Tax Levy for the 2019-2020 school year:

RESOLVED, the budget of the necessary claims and expenditures in the Roslyn Union Free School District in the Towns of North Hempstead and Oyster Bay for the school year 2019-20 amounting to \$113,190,196 for "School Purposes" and \$5,117,969 for "Library Purposes" totaling \$118,308,165 is hereby accepted, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Education has estimated the revenue from all other sources including State Aid to be \$18,150,368; and

WHEREAS, the Library Board of Trustees has estimated the revenue from all other sources for 2019-20 to be **\$53,600**;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the sums of \$95,039,828 for "School Purposes" and \$5,064,369 for "Library Purposes" totaling \$100,104,197 being the remainder of the budget adopted as above and the net amount which must be raised by taxation for the Roslyn Union Free School District, be levied upon the taxable property of said school district as said property has been certified to the Nassau County Board of Assessors for the school year 2019-20.

RESOLVED, that the District Clerk of this School District is hereby authorized and directed, pursuant to Section 6-20.0 and amendments thereto of the Nassau County Administrative Code, to file a certified copy of these resolutions with the Nassau County Legislature and the Department of Assessment, Mineola, New York, on or before August 15, 2019.

[Note: Based on <u>tentative</u> Class 1 assessed values as of April 1, 2019 of \$7,553,174 (which will be finalized by the Nassau County Assessor) and <u>uncertified</u> Class 1 base proportion of .8134569 (which will be calculated by the Nassau County Assessor and certified by the Nassau County

Legislature) the <u>estimated</u> tax levy in Class 1 (residential) for school purposes will be \$77,310,804 (an increase of 1.97%) and for library purposes will be \$4,119,646 (a decrease of 0.16%) resulting in <u>estimated</u> tax rates of \$1023.554 per \$100 of Assessed Value for school purposes and \$54.542 per \$100 of Assessed Value for Library Purposes.]
