

CHAPTER 7

Present Tense of Regular *-ARE* Verbs

In Italian, all verbs belong to one of three groups (conjugations); *-are*, *-ere*, *-ire*, based on the last three letters of the infinitive.

EXAMPLES: *parlare* *scrivere* *dormire*

1. Endings for Regular *-ARE* Verbs

The present tense of *-are* verbs is formed by dropping the infinitive ending *-are* and replacing it with the specific ending for each subject pronoun as in the table below.

SUBJECT PRONOUNS	ENDINGS
io	-o
tu (familiar)	-i
lui/lei	-a
Lei (formal)	-a
noi	-iamo
voi (familiar)	-ate
loro	-ano
Lui (formal)	-ano

2. Conjugating Regular *-ARE* Verbs

parlare to speak		
io	parlo	<i>I speak, I am speaking</i>
tu (familiar)	parli	<i>you speak, you are speaking</i>
lui/lei	parla	<i>he/she speaks, he/she is speaking</i>
Lei (formal)	parla	<i>you speak, you are speaking</i>
noi	parliamo	<i>we speak, we are speaking</i>
voi (familiar)	parlate	<i>you speak, you are speaking</i>
loro	parlano	<i>they speak, they are speaking</i>
Loro (formal)	parlano	<i>you speak, you are speaking</i>

3. Commonly Used *-ARE* Verbs

abitare to live

aiutare to help

cercare to look for

chiamare to call

amare to love
arrivare to arrive
ascoltare to listen
aspettare to wait for
ballare to dance
camminare to walk
cantare to sing
guardare to look
imparare to learn
incontrare to meet
insegnare to teach
invitare to invite
lavare to wash
lavorare to work
mangiare to eat
nuotare to swim
pagare to pay
parlare to speak, to talk
pensare to think

cominciare to begin
comprare to buy
cucinare to cook
desiderare to wish, to desire
domandare to ask
entrare to enter, to come in
giocare to play (an activity or sport)
portare to bring, to carry
praticare to practice
preparare to prepare
ritornare to return
sperare to hope
spiegare to explain
studiare to study
suonare to play (an instrument)
usare to use
viaggiare to travel
visitare to visit

NOTES: 1. Verbs ending in *-iare* retain only one *i* in the *tu* and *noi* forms.

EXAMPLES: **cominciare**

Tu cominci.

Noi cominciamo.

2. Verbs ending in *-care* and *-gare* add an *h* in the *tu* and *noi* forms.

EXAMPLES: **giocare**

Tu giochi.

Noi giochiamo.

pagare

Tu paghi.

Noi paghiamo.
