Meeting called to order by Chair, Kelly Denig.

Director's Report

- Minutes from the June 11, 2020 Policy Board meeting unanimously approved.
- Wendy Svitek, Director, attended the Statewide Leadership Team (SLT) meeting via Zoom on July 20th and July 21st. Discussion was held on Fall Focus and Spring Symposium where the new social emotional learning (SEL) curriculum and CRE curriculum will be the major topics.
- Kelly Denig, Chair, reviewed and discussed the Teacher Center By-Laws that had been
 emailed to all Policy Board members. She also emphasized the importance of having a
 quorum in order to approve motions and expenditures. Fifty-one percent of the Policy Board
 must be present and fifty-one percent of those present must be teachers. It is therefore critical
 that Wendy Svitek be notified when a Policy Board member cannot attend a meeting.
- Kelly Denig, Chair, reviewed and discussed Open Meeting Law (OML) and reminded Policy Board members to save the Power Point on OML for future reference.

Budget Report

- 1. Expenditures for 2020-2021 unanimously approved.
 - a. Wendy Svitek also discussed the large number of Collegial Circles that are occurring during the summer in order to prepare for distance learning and new conditions in classrooms due to covid-19 health and safety requirements. Paperwork for 28 Collegial Circles have been submitted thus far but there will be more. Because the Teacher Center budget has been exhausted due to this increase in professional development courses and Collegial Circles, Wendy reviewed the costs that are beyond our budget and explained how they will be paid for by the District's General Fund.

Other Business

1. New dates for the Teacher Center Meetings have been posted on the website and the school calendar for the 2020-2021 School Year. It was noted that all meetings will be held via Zoom with a 3:30 PM start time if we are conducting distance learning throughout the district. If we are physically present at school for instruction, meeting time will be moved to 4:30 to allow Policy Board members time to get home at the end of the school day. (Buildings will close shortly after student dismissal to allow time for disinfection so teachers will not be able to attend virtual meetings from their classrooms). Dates are as follows:
